## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' or better across Years 7 -10 in English, Math and Science to 90% or greater
- Ensure that Clermont State High School improvement and achievement in Year 9 writing is similar to the Nation for Mean Scale Score (MSS) and Upper Two Bands (U2B)
- 100% students in Years 7-9 show significant improvement (three markers or more) on Literacy Continuum

## Our initiatives include

- Implementing whole school approach to case management including co-planning and co-teaching as identified in case management inquiry planning
- Building the capability of teachers to recognise teaching and reflect on literacy demands of units
- Continuing to employ Head of Department – Teaching and Learning to support the implementation of case management processes, whole school writing improvement, and coaching and feedback
