- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students in Writing to above National Minimum Standard (NMS) to 90%.

Our initiatives include

- Coaching and professional development based on the Prep-10 Literacy Continuum.
- Building the capacity of teachers to recognise, teach and reflect on literacy demands of units and assessment items to ensure all classrooms provide opportunities for students to develop writing demands.
- Continuing to employ Head of Department (HOD) Curriculum to support the implementation of whole school writing improvement strategy.
- Ensuring pedagogical continuity and school-wide alignment through provision of professional development of teaching staff.
